| Growing Season | A good growing season produced good quality, average yields. The vine canopy was managed so as to ensure shading of the fruit preventing sunburn and preserving the delicate varietal characters. |
| Winemaking | The crushed grapes were drained and pressed to stainless steel tanks and the juice was cold settled. The clarified juice was then cold fermented using a selected pure yeast strain. Early bottling of this wine has ensured the retention of freshness and varietal aroma. |

| Colour | Pale straw. |
| Nose | Generous tropical fruit is complemented by just a hint of fresh cut grass. |
| Palate | The palate delivers a mouthful of delicate fruit with a balanced clean and crisp finish. |
